

## Appendix 2 (IEC 529 International Protection Code (IP Code)

According to IEC 529 (BS EN 60529:1992), products are separated into different levels by its Ingress Protection performance. The first digit means the protection against foreign objects and the second digit means the protection against liquid as follows:
